Although COVID safety rules have begun to change, the Law Library asks you to help maintain the health and safety of library visitors and staff. Please comply with the following Library Reopening Safety Rules in addition to our ongoing [Patron Rules of Conduct](#) and [Technology Policy](#).

Library Reopening Safety Rules March 2022

IN ORDER TO ENTER AND USE THE LAW LIBRARY SAFELY, VISITORS SHALL COMPLY WITH THE FOLLOWING:

- **In order to enter and use the library, visitors must wear a well-fitted mask/face covering at all times:**
 - The library security guard at the library's 4th floor front door will permit entry to the library for those wearing masks. If you don't have a mask, ask the security guard for a mask to enter.
 - Non-vented N95, KN95, or KF94 respirator masks are strongly recommended
 - A well-fitting surgical/procedural mask with a cloth mask worn over it to increase fit is also recommended
 - Cloth masks alone are no longer permitted
- **Users must apply hand sanitizer upon entering the library space:**
 - Hand sanitizers & antiseptic wipes stations are provided throughout the library
 - Everyone must wipe down surfaces including tables, keyboards, mouse, etc. with provided sanitizing wipes after use
 - Please dispose of used wipes in waste baskets, not blue recycle bins
- **Maintain social distance of 6 feet between visitors and staff:**
 - Maintain social distance at public computers and service desks
 - Only 2 people 6 feet apart are permitted at each library study table, except a party of 2 or more who are working together
 - Only 1 person allowed per available, designated public computer
 - Only one person permitted in each restroom at a time
- **Do not move furniture without staff permission**
- **Eating and drinking are not permitted in the library**
- **Please ask library staff for a mask, sanitizer, or disinfecting wipes as needed**
