Westlaw provides search capability across all subscribed content, with access to all federal and state cases, statutes, and regulations. Secondary sources include Rutter Group Practice Guides, All Briefs, All Forms; CA Legislative History, Jury Verdicts and Settlements, Federal and State Court Dockets, CA Trial Court Documents, and a range of other topical materials.



Lexis Advance provides search capability for case law, statutes, and regulatory materials, with Shepard's to update or validate citations with editorial analysis. Secondary sources include CA Forms of Pleading & Practice, CA Legal Forms, CA Points & Authorities, and Matthew Bender California practice materials, along with a wide range of other topical materials and news sources.

OnLAW, the online library of California Continuing Education of the Bar, provides full text access to professional California practice materials and forms, with search capabilities across all topical libraries and sources.



CEB Essential Forms enables patrons to fill out and print completed California Judicial Council Forms, San Francisco local court forms and other useful forms.



HeinOnline content includes law reviews and journals, archived editions of U.S. Code and regulations, classic legal titles, and other content libraries, searchable by keyword or by citation. All law journals within HeinOnline are also searchable through the San Francisco Law Library catalog. Case citations in law reviews link to **Fastcase**.



Fastcase offers a search engine for cases, statutes, and regulations, with ranking features for relevancy. Pairs with **HeinOnline** database for access to law reviews.



Lexis Digital Library provides free remote access to our collection of LexisNexis eBooks, including a wide range of California and general legal topics. Patrons can check out up to 10 eBooks at a time for up to 7 days.



Dissomaster is a California support calculation software program to produce financial reports required in California Family Law proceedings.
